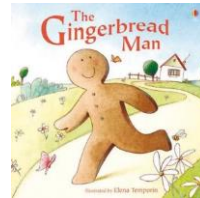
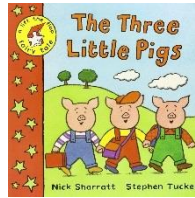
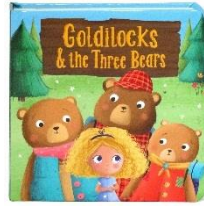
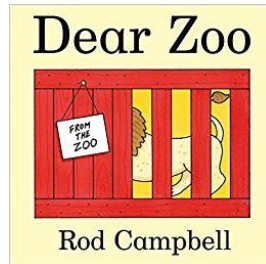
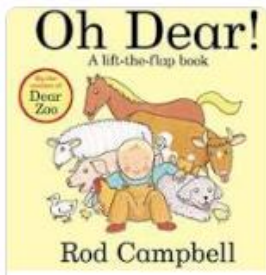


Harehills Primary School Parent's Newsletter

You can help your child at home by modelling positional language and counting at every opportunity that you can. For example, counting the steps as you walk up them on the way out of school.
