**I no go to the into she he you they we me be your**

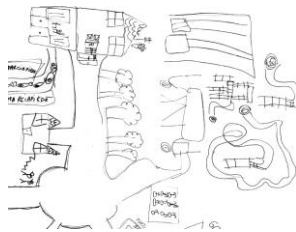
These words are to be learnt by sight. They cannot be sounded out or blended. Please check your child's reading record to check what has been taught so far.

## In Maths we will be learning:

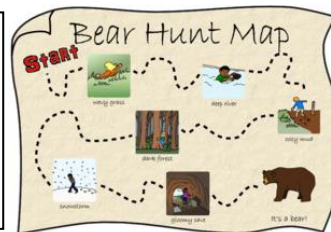
We will be teaching the children to recognise numbers up to 9.
